Wisconsin Nursery Directory¹

Retailers of Seedlings and Transplants of Common Forest Tree Species of Wisconsin

About This Directory

To compile the original nursery directory, questionnaires were sent to the more than 200 nurseries listed as growers of tree seedlings and transplants among Wisconsin's 739 licensed nursery growers. We are planning a complete resurvey of licensed nursery growers in 2002.

Because this directory is intended to aid the private landowner, only those nurseries that responded as retailers of forest seedlings were included. All nurseries that were listed in this edition of this directory were asked to update their information, if necessary, for this revision.

Annual sales volumes are included only as an indication of nursery size. This will help landowners find a nursery that can supply their needs. Prices are not included in the directory, as they change frequently and vary greatly with age, size and quality of the plants. Write or call the nursery directly for price quotes. **UW-Extension has no more information about the nurseries than is presented here.**

Seedlings versus Transplants

This directory makes a distinction between "seedlings" and "transplants." Both are suitable for direct planting into a plantation or woodlot.

"Seedlings" are young trees purchased directly from the seedbed after they are one to three years old. "Transplants" have been transplanted from the seedbed and allowed to grow another one to two years in a transplant bed.

A general rule of thumb is that transplants are more sturdy and vigorous than seedlings, and may be better suited for establishment on difficult sites. However, transplants are often much more expensive than seedlings and may not be economical for large-scale applications.

How to Use This Directory

1. Twenty of the most commonly planted forest tree species head the columns on the second page of the table. Choose a species that interests you.
2. Under each species name, the columns are subdivided into seedlings (S) and transplants (T). Follow either the S or T side of the column under the chosen species. An "X" indicates that the nursery carries the particular item. A blank box indicates that the nursery does not sell that item.

Notice: UW-Madison's Department of Forest Ecology and Management and UW-Extension have no additional information beyond what is presented here. **Contact the nurseries directly for prices or more information.** All sales data were provided by the nurseries themselves.

3. For each nursery, a letter code (A-E) for each species, labeled “A,” is given to indicate the quantity of seedlings and transplants the nursery sells annually. The letter code legend is at the bottom of the table.
4. Identify the nursery or nurseries that sell the species and can handle the volume of seedlings or transplants you desire.
5. Nurseries are listed alphabetically by county. Although most of the nurseries will ship orders via UPS or another carrier (as noted in the SHIP column), buying “close to home” allows you to inspect the nursery stock before you purchase, and may save on shipping costs.
6. Contact the nurseries directly for price quotes, to order or for more information on their products.
